
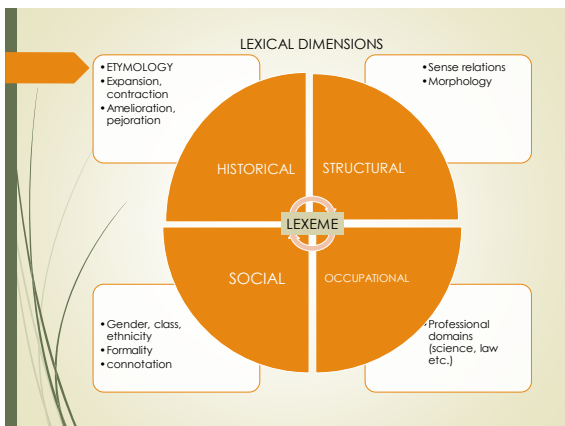

- ## LANGUAGE FLUENCY
- know and use 20 vowels, 24 consonants and 300 ways of combining them
 - have an active vocabulary of up to 50,000 w. plus a passive vocabulary of an additional 25,000
 - understand at least 1000 grammatical aspects of sentence and word formation
 - master hundreds of prosodic features (pitch, speed, loudness etc.)
 - ???# of rules for combining sentences in spoken discourse
 - ???# of strategies for *bending all these rules* for specific rhetorical purposes
 - transfer all of these skills to *writing*



LEXICAL DIMENSIONS

- **Sense relations:** conventions that govern word interaction in relation to their meaning;
- **Morphology:** conventions that govern word construction

Morphology: word construction

- DERIVATIONAL MORPHOLOGY:
 - WORK: WORK**PLACE**, WORK**ER**, WORK**ADAY**
- INFLECTIONAL MORPHOLOGY: grammatical difference
 - I work, you work, he works
 - I was working, I worked
